Tournament Rules & Regulations

- Match Schedules: All draws will be displayed at the tournament venue (Salvador do Mundo Sports Ground) and on the official WA Channel. Players are required to be present at least 30 minutes before their scheduled match time.
- Punctuality: Failure to report on time may result in a walkover being awarded to the opponent at the discretion of the tournament committee.
- Entry Rejection: The organisers reserve the right to reject any entry without explanation.
- No use of audible obscenities anywhere within the tournament site. No obscene gestures or actions of any kind.
- No verbal abuse (direct or indirect) towards referees, opponents, spectators, or staff. No aggressive behaviour such as violently hitting or throwing rackets or tennis balls.
- The Tournament Director, in consultation with the organising committee and venue management, will have the final say on all matters.
- In case of the ball hitting the roof, the point will be given to the person on the receiving side.
- Please do not wear the same shoes that are used outside on the court.

Tournament Standard Operating Procedures

- Kindly adhere to the instructions from The Tournament Director, and has the lastcall on any issue.
- Parents/Guardians should always be outside the playing area.
- Any person exhibiting any symptom attributed to COVID or any other contagious disease will be immediately prevented from entering the tournament venue(s).
- Symptoms could be:
 - Cough
 - Sore Throat
 - Fever (e.g. night sweats or chills)
 - Shortness of breath
- Do not spit on the ground.
- All other rules and/or guidelines released by local administration/state will apply.
